8. Which one of the Peter's descriptions in verse 9 resonates with you the most?
 - explain in your own words what this 'title' means to you

10. How are we to be 'built up as a spiritual house'?
 - How does that look in practical terms today?
11. How can we be a stumbling block to those around us?
